

Discount points can be obtained on the following activities -

- **Working party at tournaments. (Including field prep work and tournament organiser)**
- **Manning of Tea Tent**
- **Ground and equipment maintenance**
- **Assisting on beginners courses**
- **Assisting at have-a-go's**
- **Membership of the waterside committee**
- **Other activities at the committees discretion**

Club member will be responsible for maintaining a record of the work they have done in this log book which should be counter signed by a committee member and presented to the treasurer with their renewal to obtain the discount

Discount scheme rules -

- All work carried out will be organised and approved by waterside archers.
- Your work log MUST be signed by a member of the committee for each activity undertaken to verify the work and the amount claimed.
- Each hour worked will be eligible for a 1% discount on your membership fee up to a maximum of 50%
- Being a Member of the waterside committee makes you eligible to start at 10% still reaching a maximum of 50%
- Both senior and junior members are eligible for the discounts at their relative rates.
- The scheme will apply to hours worked, and not necessarily to hours attended . For activities such as a working party at a tournament where work is sporadic through the day, the committee will advise on how many hours can be claimed.
- The scheme will be reviewed annually by the committee and any amendments circulated to the club members.
